

What is Canvas?



Canvas is an Online Learning Management Software Program. It is available through any web browser or as an app on your smartphone or mobile device. It streamlines classroom work to one location where teachers can post and grade assignments, and students can complete work and receive feedback from teachers. Canvas was adopted by the State of NC in 2014 for all public school districts. UNCC, CPCC, and NCVPS have also adopted the use of Canvas.

How do students access Canvas?

NC Ed Cloud is a service delivery platform or one stop log in for all students to access accounts provided and supported through the North Carolina Department of Public Instruction. In other words, by logging into their NC Ed Cloud, students have access to all of their digital accounts without having to remember multiple logins.






Create your account

Select a secure password you can remember and make sure you enter your email address correctly.


CMS will not be able to help you recover your password but you will have an option to have a reset link emailed to you.

Enter your student's login and password


Your student's *Username* is their *studentID*.


Your student will probably know their *password*, but if they do not, their *teacher can help reset* the password and communicate it to you.
